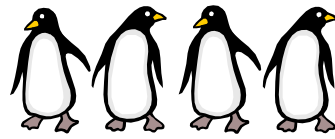

## Our Weekly Themes this month are:



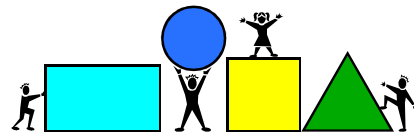
**Penguins:** We will be making several different kinds of penguins. Please send in any empty toilet paper rolls you might have.
